By popular demand, this year the market will be open weekly. The main market will take place on the 2nd Thursday of each month from 4-6pm. In the intervening weeks, CalaverasGROWN will operate a farm stand in the same location offering many of the same products and a pick-up option for special orders.

Thanks to a grant from Mark Twain Health Care District, CalaverasGROWN is offering a weekly financial incentive called 'Market Bucks' to Calaveras Government Center and MTMC employees. They simply need to show their employee ID badge to receive free Market Bucks to use as cash at the market. Watch for the weekly announcement from your employer to find out how much is offered each week. At the opening market on June 13, employees will receive \$5 Market Bucks.

The market and farm stand both feature a wide variety of products from local farms right here in Calaveras County. All the money you spend goes directly to the farmers and supports our local economy.
